

**a. Drug Court:**

Jessy Prokosch reported graduation coming up shortly; talking with Pathways to share a Peer Support Specialist; September is recovery month.

**b. Mental Health Court – group update:**

Anna Carlson provided highlights from task force research: no mental health court specific funding identified, with most counties using levy. The majority of people who enter the system are found to have both substance abuse and mental health issues. Adding mental health services to the current treatment court program is an option, with the funding source yet to be determined.
