INFORMATIONAL: 2021 Assembly Bill 838 – Minimum bail for Certain Cases: Under this bill, a judge may not release a defendant without bail or an unsecured bond if the defendant has a previous conviction for a felony or a violent misdemeanor. Such a defendant may be released only if he or she executes a secured bond or deposits cash in lieu of a bond in an amount of at least \$10,000. If this bill passes, the jail may be impacted.
