Ann Doucette facilitated meeting.

Present –Rosemary Lear, Pat Ryan, Ann Doucette, Carolyn Pierce, Candy Holm-Anderson, Sue Sandvick.  
Absent – Keith Allen, Joel Certa-Werner, Anna Carlson. Others present –Kelly Burger (CASDA) , Ashby Rawstern (Superior Vocations Center, Inc.)

The following requests for funding for 2021 were received:

- (1) Center Against Sexual & Domestic Abuse (CASDA) in the amount of \$30,000;  
and
- (2) Superior Vocations Center in the amount of \$35,000.

Corporation Counsel Pierce advised that the request from CASDA falls under the statutory authority, but the request from Superior Vocations Center does not.

Doucette noted that CASDA was funded at \$20,000 in 2020. Superior Vocations Center could be funded through H&HS as a contract, if there is a determination that there is need.

Burger and Rawstern responded to questioning.

**Action:** Motion by Lear, second Ryan, to recommend funding of Center Against Sexual & Domestic Abuse in the amount of \$30,000 to the joint meeting of the Administration and Executive Committees. Committee stressed this funding level may not be sustainable next year. Motion carried.

**Action:** Motion by Lear, second Ryan, to deny funding for Superior Vocations Center as it does not meet statutory criteria. Motion carried.
