County Board Chair Mark Liebaert announced that this public hearing is being held pursuant to Section 59.10(3)(b), of the Wisconsin Statutes, for public comment on the proposed tentative plan for the county and municipal redistricting.

Present – Sue Sandvick, Mark Liebaert, Mary Lou Bergman, Sue Hendrickson, Ron Leino, Michael Raunio, Pat Ryan, Jim Borgeson, Skylar Schoh, Nick Raverty, Kaci Lundgren, Committee Clerk.

County Clerk, Sue Sandvick, stated that redistricting is required every ten years to account for population changes due to the census.

The release of data was delayed from the U.S. Census Bureau due to pandemic and other contributing factors; data received in August as compared to February/March in previous redistricting years. Because of this, redistricting was done on a condensed timeline, with a final plan to be adopted in early November.

Sandvick reviewed district changes throughout county, including City of Superior; the overall deviation range of proposed plan is 9.77%; goal was to be under 10%.

No one from the public was in attendance for comment.
