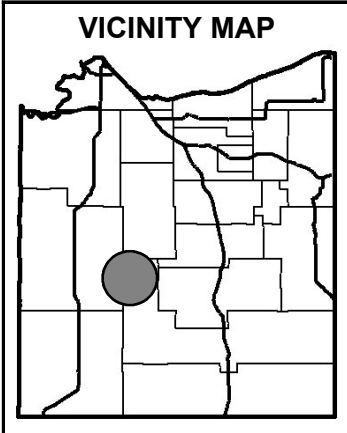

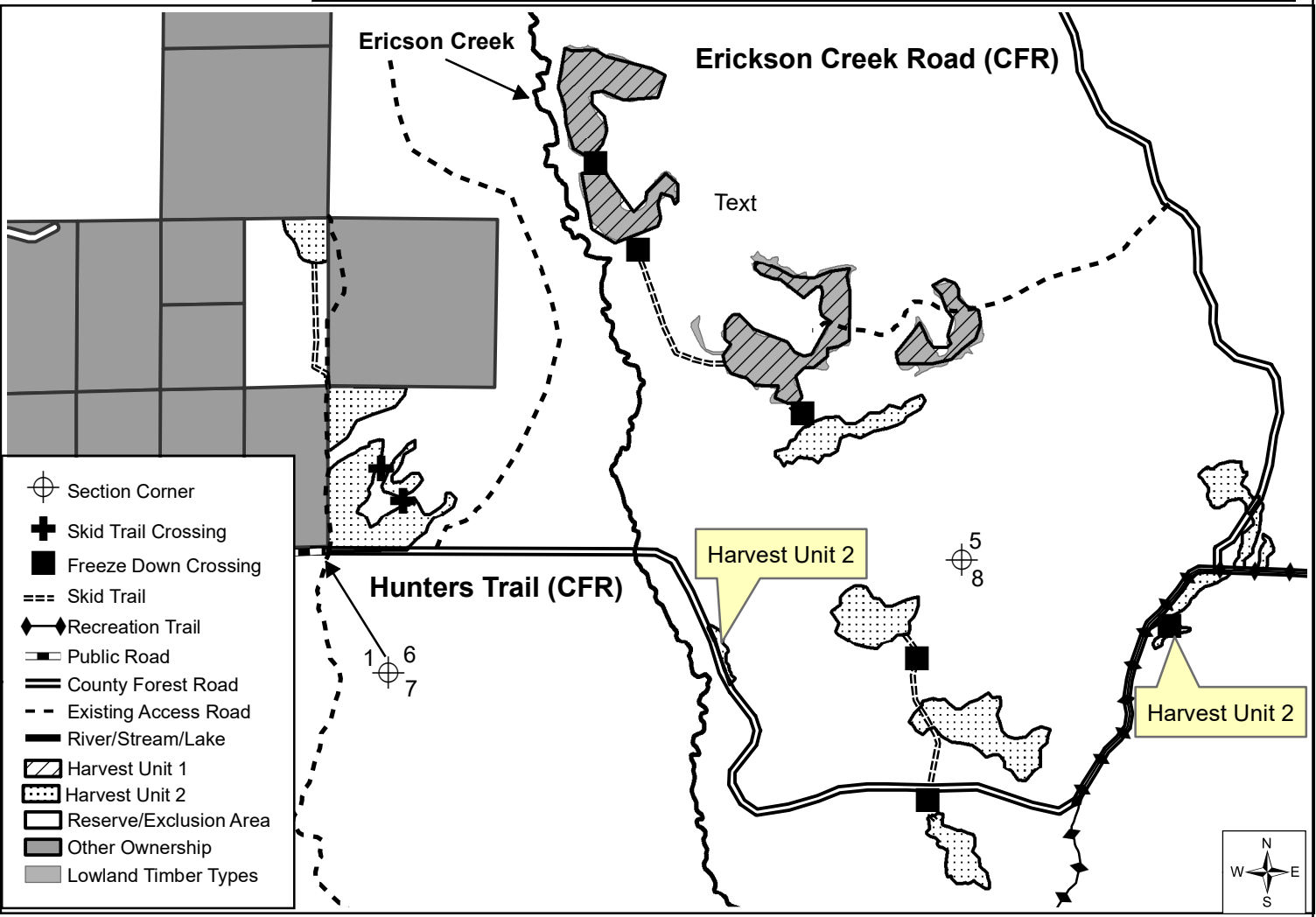

The Mixed HW volume contains approximately 75% Red Maple, 13% Sugar Maple, 6% White Birch, 5% Ash, & 1% Misc. The Black Spruce volume contains approximately 59% Black Spruce & 41% Balsam Fir.



## **TRACT 5-21 (HIDDEN GEM) – SUPPLEMENTAL REQUIREMENTS**

The following terms and conditions supplement those provided in the Douglas County Timber Sale Contract:

### **A. PRESCRIPTION -**

- Harvest unit 1 has a seed tree harvest prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 24ft<sup>2</sup>.
- Harvest unit 2 has a clear-cut harvest prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 8ft<sup>2</sup>.

### **B. SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS -**

- All harvesting operations are not restricted by season or time of the year on an estimated 25% of the harvest area (uplands) and shall be limited to frozen ground conditions or unusually dry conditions only on an estimated 75% of the harvest area (lowlands). Contact the Sale Administrator for further information.

### **C. TREES DESIGNATED FOR CUTTING -**

- Harvest unit 1, fell all aspen and red maple stems; all 7-inch and greater DBH black spruce and 9-inch and greater white birch stems; and all balsam fir stems that contain at a minimum, two 4" Roundwood Products. Skid and haul all felled stems that meet the product and utilization standards as per product bid.
- Harvest unit 2, fell all aspen, sugar maple, red maple, and ash stems; and all balsam fir stems that contain at a minimum, two 4" Roundwood Product. Skid and haul all felled stems that meet the product and utilization standards as per product bid.

### **D. TREES DESIGNATED FOR LEAVING -**

- In harvest unit 1, reserve and leave undamaged all tamarack and white pine stems; all less than 7-inch DBH black spruce and all less than 9-inch DBH white birch stems; and all balsam fir stems that do not contain at a minimum, two 4" Roundwood Product.
- In harvest unit 2, reserve and leave undamaged all white birch, yellow birch, white spruce, black spruce, and white pine stems; and all balsam fir stems that do not contain at a minimum, two 4" Roundwood Product.

### **E. HARVEST AND OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS -**

- Spruce slash shall remain within the areas where these species were harvested.
- Access road system shall be utilized for product decking.
- Landings will be restricted to a small back-in turn-arounds with locations identified during the pre-operations meeting.
- Operations shall minimize to the greatest extent possible any damage to advanced regeneration.
- Some harvest units shall only be accessed by skid trails as designated.
- Six skid trail "Freeze Down Crossings" shall be constructed as designated. All equipment operation and skidding in these portions of the sale areas shall be limited to these crossings.

### **F. ACCESS AND ROADS -**

- No winter vehicular access (in or out) to the east of Ericson Creek Road on Hunters Trail or from the existing access to harvest unit 1 to the north on Ericson Creek Road shall be permitted.
- The total length of the existing access road system is approximately 4,300 feet.
- 1,250 feet of existing access road will require "Class 3" construction. The remaining portions may require minimal "Class 3" reconstruction before use.
- Hunters Trail Road and Ericson Creek Road are County Forest Roads.
- A portion of Hunters Trail Road is a winter snowmobile trail.
- Access across land under other ownership has been secured by the County.

### **G. OTHER -**

- Note skidding distances.
- The black spruce cord volume contains a large percentage of bolt sized material 8 inch average stem diameter.
