

Medicare Open Enrollment is October 15th -December 7th

Medicare's Open Enrollment runs October 15th through December 7th. This is the time of year when you can make certain changes to your Medicare coverage.



You can make as many changes as you need to your Medicare coverage during Open Enrollment. The last change you make will take effect on January 1st. Take action during Open Enrollment to ensure your coverage will meet your needs in 2023.

The changes you can make include:

- Joining a new Medicare Advantage Plan or Part D prescription drug plan
- Switching from Original Medicare to a Medicare Advantage Plan
- Switching from a Medicare Advantage Plan to Original Medicare (with or without a Part D plan)

Ask yourself the following questions before choosing a Part D drug plan:

- Does the plan cover all the medications I take?
- Does the plan have restrictions on my drugs?
- How much will I pay for monthly premiums and the annual deductible?
- How much will I pay at the pharmacy (copay/coinsurance) for each drug I take?
- Is my pharmacy in the plans' preferred network?
- Can I fill my prescriptions by mail order?
- What is the plan's star rating?
- If I have retiree coverage, will the Medicare drug plan work with this coverage?

You can also make changes to your coverage by doing the following:

- Calling 1-800-MEDICARE to make changes over the phone
- Visiting www.medicare.gov to make changes online
- Calling a plan directly to enroll (after getting all information in writing)
